BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 6, 2013, Handivan Transports, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

Description	Proposed
In City Transports One Way	\$32.00
Waiting Time	\$37/hour
If client uses Handivan Oxygen	\$10.00

Waiting time is defined as when the vehicle is out of service for other transports; no charge for the first fifteen minutes.

Emergency action is requested.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1808. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by wheelchair accessible vans in open class service over irregular routes between points within the Omaha corporate city limits. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1808 on May 14, 2013. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its

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certificate as granted until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the Application on an emergency basis. The Commission further finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective May 17, 2013.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective May 17, 2013, Handivan Transports, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:

Description	Rate
In City Transports One Way	\$32.00
Waiting Time	\$37/hour
If client uses Handivan Oxygen	\$10.00

Waiting time is defined as when the vehicle is out of service for other transports; no charge for the first fifteen minutes

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that public notice of this action be published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, pursuant to the provisions of Section 75-121. R.R.S. 2012, and the Commission Rules.
