On June 17, 2013, Student Transportation of Nebraska, Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1836. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by charter bus over irregular routes for OPS/Millard school district consisting also of field trips, activity runs, athletic events, and charter service over irregular routes outside of the contract with OPS/Millard school districts. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1837 on June 25, 2013. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.
