#### O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

The Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1771, Supplement 3, which reads as follows:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter in the state of Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1771, Supplement 3 on November 5, 2013. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges, as well as rates charged by other transportation companies providing a similar service..

The Commission finds that the rates as proposed are reasonable and should be approved. The rates are competitive when compared to similar companies providing a similar service.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under this Supplement until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the Application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 15, 2013.


