OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 6, 2015, Omaha Brew Bus, LLC, Omaha, filed an application for authority to establish its rates as follows:

Private Charter (Monday-Thursday)	\$150/first 2 hours \$65 each additional hour
Private Charter (Friday-Sunday)	\$400/first 4 hours \$80 each additional hour

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1917. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No. The Certificate was granted on November 17, 2015.

The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis. The Commission further finds that the proposed rates to be approved in this Order are reasonable.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 20, 2015.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Omaha Brew Bus, LLC, Omaha, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its services on an emergency basis effective November 20, 2015, as follows:
