OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 22, 2016, Norton Enterprises, LLC, d/b/a Heartland Party Bus, Omaha, filed an application for authority to establish its rates as follows:

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate No. B-1923. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The

transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No. The Certificate was granted on March 1, 2016.

Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The proposed rates are competitive with rates currently used by companies providing a similar service. The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such an emergency exists in this application as Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective March 4, 2016.
