Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate No. B-1928. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by bus between all points in Nebraska. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No. The Certificate was granted on June 16, 2016.

Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable. The Commission further finds that any advertised specials must have a defined start date and end date as well as the advertised rate being specifically set forth in the advertising.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such an emergency exists in this application as Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective June 24, 2016.

### ORDER
