On November 10, 2016, Midwest Medivan Transport Company, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application for authority to establish its rates as follows:

0-4 Miles	\$45.00 one way per passenger
5-55 miles	\$2.50 per mile
Additional miles	\$1.90 per mile

Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 15, 2016. No protests were filed.

Applicant is a certificated carrier that holds Certificate No. B-1927. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by van between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and HHS designation is no. The Certificate was granted on October 4, 2016.

Applicant is establishing its initial rates for use in this Certificate. The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted effective October 17, 2016.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Midwest Medivan Transport Company, LLC, Omaha, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its services effective December 25, 2016, as follows:
