O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On November 10, 2016, Galaxy Shuttle Party Bus ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application for authority to establish its rates as follows:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Proposed</u>
Small Bus (under 20 passengers)	\$90/hour
Large Bus (20 passengers or more)	\$125/hour
Hourly Minimums:	Before 6:00 p.m.: 3 hours After 6:00 p.m.: 4 hours

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 14, 2016. No protests were filed.

Applicant is a certificated carrier that holds Certificate No. B-1919. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by bus, equipped to carry 12 passengers or more on a statewide basis, utilizing a fleet of no more than 4 buses in the first 4 years of the date of the Certificate. The following restrictions apply: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Service is restricted in the counties of Cass, Douglas, Lancaster, Sarpy, Saunders, and Washington as follows: Along regular routes between stops in entertainment districts of which Galaxy Shuttle Party Bus has provided the Commission with prior written notice. The use of sedans of any type is not authorized. The transportation of passengers to or from Eppley Airfield is not authorized. The transportation of passengers to or from areas zoned residential is not authorized. The transportation of passengers upon street hails is not authorized. The HHS Designation is no. The application for authority was granted on February 22, 2017.

Applicant is seeking to establish its rates in order to begin its operations. The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.
