OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 8, 2017, Good Times Bus Company ("Applicant"), Norfolk, filed an application for authority to establish its rates as follows:

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated carrier that holds Certificate Number B-1941. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage by bus in special party and charter between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS designation is no. The application for authority was granted on March 21, 2017.

Applicant is seeking to establish its rates for use with its Certificate. The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as Applicant cannot begin to operate until the Commission approves the application. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.
