OPINION AND FINDINGS

On April 10, 2017, Ambassador Transportation, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application for authority to amend its rates as follows:

Description
From 0-10 miles within the
City limit per trip, from
point of origin to point of
delivery, per person:

<u>Current</u> <u>Proposed</u> \$16.98/trip \$15.75/trip

Wheelchair Rate:

Within City Limit Fixed \$40/trip \$34/trip
Rate- one way
Outside of City Limit from Fixed Rate Plus Fixed Rate Plus
point of origin to point of \$1.70/mile \$1.49/mile
delivery, per person

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated carrier that holds Certificate Number B-1886. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage by van between points in Douglas County. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS designation is yes. The authority was granted on January 6, 2015.

Applicant is seeking to amend its rates in order to remain competitive in the market and to better sustain its business. This is the first time that Applicant has come to the Commission to seek a reduction in the fixed rate and mileage charges. Applicant still plans to provide transportation for HHS, and

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Commission staff will work with HHS staff to ensure that Applicant receives the appropriate reimbursement amounts according to its proposed rate application. The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as Applicant should be placed in a position to take advantage of its new rates as soon as possible. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective April 18, 2017.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Ambassador Transportation, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska be, and it is hereby, authorized to amend its rates for its services on an emergency basis effective April 18, 2017, as follows:

Description

From 0-10 miles within the City limit per trip, from point of origin to point of delivery, per person:

Rate \$15.75/trip

Wheelchair Rate:

Within City Limit Fixed Rate- one way
Outside of City Limit from point of
origin to point of delivery, per person

\$34/trip Fixed Rate Plus \$1.49/mile
