On October 11, 2017, Airport Transportation Company, d/b/a Van Go, ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application for authority to establish its open class rates as follows:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Proposed Rate</u>
Any individual, group, business, of Governmental entity that requires automated billing through proprietary modes	\$38.00
0-5 miles (includes up to 3 passengers)	\$20.00
Each Additional Mile or part thereof	\$2.00
Each additional passenger per mile or part thereof	\$0.50

Emergency action is requested.

On October 31, 2017, Applicant was granted an extended authority under Application No. B-1123 to transport passengers and baggage by vans between points in Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy Counties, and between points in said counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes, with the following restrictions: the transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized; HHS designation is authorized.

Applicant is seeking to establish its initial published rate in order to provide transportation services for its clients. The Commission finds that the proposed rate is reasonable.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as Applicant should be placed in a position to begin providing transportation services as soon as possible. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists

that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 7, 2017.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Airport Transportation Company, d/b/a Van Go, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish its open class rates for its services on an emergency basis effective November 7, 2017, as follows:
