BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 15, 2018, Lift Medical Transportation, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its rates for its use in its operations as follows:

Description

Non-Emergency Wheelchair \$41.37

Van One-Way Trip Base Rate,
Wholly within Corporate
City Limits of Omaha or
Lincoln

Emergency action is requested.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1948. The certificate authorizes transporting passengers by van in open class service between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Cass, and Washington Counties. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

Applicant is seeking to amend its published rates for non-emergency transportation using wheelchair vans. The current base rate for one-way trips, wholly within the corporate city limits of Omaha or Lincoln, is \$41.37. Applicant is amending this rate to \$37.00 as the base rate for non-emergency transportation in a wheelchair van, one-way, wholly within the corporate city limits of Lincoln or Omaha. Applicant requests this decrease in hopes it will increase business with Intelliride. This rate utilizes language from the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services regarding transportation rates. The rate would only be applicable to the corporate city limits of Omaha as the Applicant does not have authority to provide service in Lancaster County.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as Applicant should be placed in a position to begin receiving additional trips in NDHHS transportation. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 27, 2018.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Lift Medical Transportation, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to amend its rates for its services on an emergency basis effective November 27, 2018, as follows:

Base Rate, Wholly within Corporate City
Limits of Omaha or Lincoln
