OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 20, 2000, Glenn Todd Lanham, dba Central Limo Service, Central City, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish limousine rates for its use as follows:

Description (See Notes)	Proposed Rate
1. Standard Limousine Service	\$65/hour
2. Waiting Time	15/hour

Note 1: Subject to \$100.00 minimum charge.

Note 2: Time begins when the limousine and driver leaves the garage and ends upon their return to the garage.

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1539. The certificate authorizes limousine service by luxury or stretch limousine in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier between points in Buffalo, Hall, Hamilton, Merrick and Nance counties, and between points in said counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

According to the applicant, the rates are based on expenses and are competitive with other limousine companies providing service in the area. The proposed rates are necessary to cover normal weekly and monthly maintenance expenses which include but are not limited to fuel, tires, insurance, licenses, taxes, and general vehicle upkeep.

Applicant recently received its authority to provide transportation services in Buffalo, Hall, Hamilton, Merrick and Nance counties. It currently does not have approved intrastate rates. The proposed rates are competitive with the rates on file for other carriers providing similar service. The application is filed in compliance with Section 75-308 (Rates) and 75-121 (Emergency rate orders), R.R.S. 1996 and the Commission rules.

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Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective December 8, 2000.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective December 8, 2000, Glenn Todd Lanham, dba Central Limo Service, Central City, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish limousine rates for its use as follows:

Description (See Notes)	Rate
1. Standard Limousine Service	\$65/hour
2. Waiting Time	15/hour

Note 1: Subject to \$100.00 minimum charge.

Note 2: Time begins when the limousine and driver leaves the garage and ends upon their return to the garage.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that public notice of this action be published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska pursuant to the provisions of Section 75-121, R.R.S. 1996, and the Commission's rules.
