Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1561. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by limousine between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington, Dodge, Lancaster, Cass, and Saunders counties, and between points in said counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The authority is restricted against transporting railroad train crews and clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Service or subcontractor thereof.

According to the Applicant, the proposed rates are based on projected income and expenses. The proposed rates are necessary to cover the cost of insurance, fuel, and vehicle maintenance. The proposed rates are believed to be sufficient to produce a reasonable profit and still maintain a quality service.

Applicant recently received its authority as a common carrier to provide limousine service. The proposed rates are based on an eighteen (18) passenger, 180 inch stretch, Lincoln Navigator 4X4, SUV. This type of vehicle is new to the Omaha Metropolitan area; consequently, a rate comparison cannot be made. Applicant submitted a projected monthly cash flow chart which if it has any validity, the Applicant will realize an approximate 20% return on its investment. The application is filed in compliance with Section 75-308 (Rates) and 75-121 (Emergency rate orders), R.R.S. 1996 and the Commission rules.
