## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 23, 2002, A Class Act Limousine Service, Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its limousine rates through the addition of notations as follows:

Note 4: Sunday through Thursday - Book 3 hours and get the 4<sup>th</sup> hour free.

Note 5: Friday and Saturday - Book 5 hours and get the 6<sup>th</sup> hour

Note 6: Proms and Homecomings - Four (4) hour minimum charge, in which the time can be split once.

Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily</u> <u>Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 28, 2002, pursuant to the Commission's rules. The application was not protested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which hold Certificate B-1538. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by luxury limousine between points within a 250-mile radius of Dakota City over irregular routes.

According to the Applicant, the requested additional notations are sought to remain competitive. Potential customers, when shopping around, have made inquires regarding the extended hour service. It is estimated that the percentage of customers who will opt for the extended service will be minimal; and, therefore, it will not affect the revenue.

There are several limousine companies in the Omaha area who offer the extended hour service to their customers. Customers accepting the extended hour service are very few. Those who do accept the extended hour do so for its entertainment value.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted.
