### OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 5, 2003, Extreme Limousine, Inc., dba A Limousine Service, Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its limousine rates as follows:

V. Standard Limousine	
A. 6 Passenger limousine	\$70/hour
Note 1: Subject to the following minimum charges:	
A. Friday & Saturday - three (3) hour minimum	
B. Sunday - Thursday - two (2) hour minimum	
Note 2: Outside the Omaha metro area, travel time will commence from the time the vehicle and driver leave the garage and end upon its return.	
Note 3: Airport transfers will be subject to a one (1) hour minimum charge and a \$25 charge per each one-half hour of wait time.	
Note 4: Special holidays: Christmas Eve, New Year's Eve, St. Patrick's Day, Valentine's Day will be subject to a four (4) hour minimum charge at \$100 per hour.	
Note 5: Prom/Homecoming/Graduation will be subject to a three (3) hour minimum charge at \$100 per hour.	
Note 6: Wedding Package (Weekends): Subject to a two (2) hour minimum Charge at a flat rate of \$180. Each additional one-half hour Of service will be charge \$46.	

#### VI. Corporate Package Rates (See Notes 1 and 2):

Uses Per Month	Rate
1-9 hours	\$60/hour
10-20 hours	50/hour
Over 20 hours	40/hour

- Note 1: Corporate rates are based on one pick up point and one drop off point within the Omaha Metro Area.
- Note 2: Each additional stop will be assessed \$20 per stop.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 7, 2003, pursuant to the Commission rules. There were no protests filed.

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The Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1561. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by limousine between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington, Dodge, Lancaster, Cass and Saunders counties, and between points in said counties on the one hand, and on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The authority is restricted against transporting railroad train crews and clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services or subcontractors thereof.

According to the Applicant, a six-passenger limousine was recently purchased. The smaller limousine is in addition to the two SUV's currently in service. The proposed rates are necessary to cover the cost of insurance, fuel, vehicle maintenance, and still produce a reasonable profit. The additional vehicle, albeit smaller, will enhance the service available to customers.

The proposed rates are competitive with the rates on file and approved for use by competing limousine carriers operating similar type of vehicles in the Omaha metropolitan area. According to the Applicant, the proposed rates are based on its investment in the vehicles, and what it believes is necessary to recoup its investment.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Extreme Limousine, Inc., dba A Limousine Service, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to amend its limousine rates as follows:
