On July 25, 2005, JT Investments, Holdrege, Nebraska filed an application for authority to establish limousine rates for its use as follows:

Description	Rates
I. Standard Hourly Rate:	\$65.00
II. Downtime Rate:	\$35.00
A. Downtime available only for hires of on (1) hour or more;	
B. Total Downtime cannot exceed the total driving time.	

Note: No mileage charge in addition to base rate and/or downtime rate.

Emergency action is requested

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1655. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by limousine service between points in Phelps, Harlan, Kearney, Franklin, Gosper and Furnas counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective September 2, 2005.
