OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 21, 2005, Steven L. Devening dba Devening Trucking, Tekamah, Nebraska, filed an application to establish limousine rates for its use as follows:

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1670. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Burt County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska. RESTERICTIONS: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. All trips must originate in Burt County. The proposed rates are necessary to cover operating costs of the applicant. They are also believed to be sufficient to produce a reasonable profit after the operating expenses and still maintain a quality service.

Applicant recently received authority to provide limousine service within its defined area. The proposed rate is competitive with other carriers providing a similar service with like equipment. The application is filed in compliance with Sections 75-308 (Rates) and 75-121 (Emergency rate orders), R.R.S. 2003 and the Commission rules.
