O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 21, 2006, James V. Meyer d/b/a Paradise Limousine Service, Blue Hill, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates and charges for its use in Nebraska intrastate commerce for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between points in Nebraska as follows:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Proposed</u>
1. Per Hour travel time	\$70.00
2. Per Hour waiting time	\$30.00

All bookings subject to a \$140.00 minimum.

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a carrier who holds Certificate No. B-1675, which permits the transportation of passengers and their baggage in limousine between points in Webster, Adams, Clay and Nuckols counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points 200 miles east of Webster County over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of railroad crews and their baggage is not authorized. Transportation must originate in Webster, Adams, Clay or Nuckols counties.

In support of this application, the Applicant states that he acquired the certificate on January 31, 2006. The Applicant states that the proposed rates are necessary to improve the service as well as improve the fleet and produce a reasonable rate of return for the applicant.

The proposed rates are similar and competitive with those rates authorized for use by other companies providing a similar service in its area. The Commission finds that these rates are reasonable. The Commission also finds that the rates should be

approved on an emergency basis due to the recent acquisition of the authority by the applicant.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective April 7, 2006.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective April 7, 2006, James V. Meyer d/b/a Paradise Limousine Service, Blue Hill, , be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish its rates for its use as follows:

Description	Rate
1. Per Hour travel time	\$70.00
2. Per Hour waiting time	\$30.00


All bookings subject to a \$140.00 minimum.
