OPINION AND FINDINGS

On August 7, 2006, VIP Limousine, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its existing rates for its use. The application would lower some rates, raise other rates and establish rates for commuter traffic within a 70 mile range of Omaha, Nebraska.

Applicant requests emergency action.

The Commission is of the opinion that the issues involved with this rate application need more study than would be allowed if the rates are granted on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application for a rate change made on an emergency basis should be denied and that the application be processed in accordance with the Commission's regular procedures and Section 75-119, R.R.S., 2003, as amended.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the matter docketed in Application No. LR-270 be, and it is hereby, denied on an emergency basis, and that said matter be processed in accordance with Commission's regular procedures and Section 75-119, R.R.S., 2003, as amended.
