OPININON AND FINDINGS

On May 4, 2009, Alvin D. Kramer, Beemer, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations. After consultation with Commission staff, the Applicant amended its application to the following proposed rate structure:

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1735. The certificate allows the transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Cuming, Burt, Thurston, and Wayne counties, and in Dodge County in the towns of Howells, Snyder, Scribner and Dodge, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. HHS Designation: No. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. No rides originating in the cities of Stanton, Hoskins, and Winside, Nebraska, in Stanton County are authorized.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1735 on May 5, 2009. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed amended rates are based upon anticipated expenses

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in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted as amended on an emergency basis effective May 15, 2009.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective May 15, 2009, Alvin D. Kramer, Beemer, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:
