OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 11, 2009, Pristine Limousine, LLC, North Platte, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations. After consultation with Commission staff, the applicant proposes the following amended application:

Weddings (per hour)	\$125.00
Proms (per hour)	\$100.00
Other Bookings (per hour)	\$ 50.00
Down Time (per hour)	One-half of Regular Rate
Outside a ten mile radius of North Platte (per mile)	\$1.25
Deposit required	\$50.00

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1741. The certificate allows the transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Red Willow, Chase, Dawson, Dundy, Frontier, Furnas, Gosper, Hayes, Keith, Lincoln and Perkins counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. HHS Designation: No. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1741 on June 23, 2009. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed amended rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted as amended on an emergency basis effective June 26, 2009.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective June 26, 2009, Pristine Limousine, LLC, North Platte, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:
