On May 6, 2010, Limousine Services, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations. After consultation with Commission staff, the applicant proposes the following application:

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Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1761. The certificate allows the transportation of passengers by luxury limousine between points within a 250-mile radius of Dakota City over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: 1) The transportation of railroad train crews is not authorized; and 2) The certificate holder shall maintain a listing of its services in the Yellow Pages of the telephone director serving Dakota City.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1761 on May 11, 2010. The Applicant is establishing rates for these particular vehicles for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed amended rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges. The rates are competitive with similar rates charges by other services for these types of vehicles.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

The Applicant has informed the Commission that it has received contracted bookings that were made by its predecessor company, A Class Act Limousine. These bookings were made under the rate structure of A Class Act Limousine under the rates approved for A Class Act. The Commission finds that these previously contracted bookings should be performed by the Applicant pursuant to the contractually agreed charges. All bookings done by the Applicant from this date forward should be pursuant to the rates as approved in this order.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective May 14, 2010.

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ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective May 14, 2010, Limousine Service, LLC, Lincoln Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for the following vehicles its use as follows:
