O P I N I O N S A N D F I N D I N G S

On April 19, 2012, Special Day Limousine, LLC, Yankton, South Dakota, filed an application for authority to establish its limousine rates for its use as follows:

Description Rates

Friday and Saturdays before 6 p.m.:

Ford Excursion \$180/hour

Chrysler 300 \$140/hour

Subject to a two hour minimum and applicable South Dakota sales tax.

All other times after 6 p.m.:

Ford Excursion \$120/hour

Chrysler 300 \$85/hour

Subject to a three hour minimum and applicable South Dakota sales tax.

Emergency action is requested.

The Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1807, which reads as follows:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: COMMON: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by luxury or stretch limousines as follows: in Knox County, a 45 mile radius from Yankton, South Dakota; in Cedar, Dixon, and Dakota counties, north of Highway 20. All transportation to originate in said geographic area.

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RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

The Applicant received authority to operate under B-1807 on April 24, 2012. This application is a request to establish the rates for use in its new service.

Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed amended rates are based upon research on the rates currently charged by other companies providing a similar service, and from customer feedback during informal market research. The rates also anticipate expenses such as vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising, and other overhead charges. The rates are competitive with similar rates charged by other services for these types of vehicles.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted as amended and modified on an emergency basis effective April 27, 2012.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective April 27, 2012, Special Day Limousine, LLC, Yankton, South Dakota, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish limousine rates for its use as follows:

<u>Friday and Saturdays before 6 p.m.:</u>	
Ford Excursion	\$180/hour
Chrysler 300	\$140/hour

Subject to a two hour minimum and applicable South Dakota sales tax.

All other times after 6 p.m.:

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Ford Excursion \$120/hour

Chrysler 300 \$85/hour

Subject to a three hour minimum and applicable South Dakota sales tax.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that public notice of this action be published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, pursuant to the provisions of Section 75-121, R.R.S. 2011, and the Commission's rules.
