Emergency action is requested.

The Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1799, which reads as follows:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: COMMON: Transportation of passengers in limousine service by luxury or stretch limousine, sedans, and SUVs within 150 mile radius of Lincoln, Nebraska, between points within such radius on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

The Applicant received authority to operate under B-1799 on March 6, 2012. At that time the Applicant established rates for a 2000 Ford Excursion. The Applicant has purchased and will place in service a 2001 Lincoln Town Car in its service. This application is a request to establish the rates for this new vehicle.

Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising, and other overhead charges. The rates are competitive with similar rates charged by other services for these types of vehicles.

The Applicant has also requested that the fuel surcharge that is not related to the distance of the trip be deleted. This charge is not necessary under the current charges as approved by the Commission. The Commission finds that this surcharge should be deleted.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted as amended and modified on an emergency basis effective September 19, 2012.
