On May 9, 2014, Accent Chauffeured Transportation, LLC, Omaha, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

- 4. Service outside of the Omaha Metropolitan area will be calculated garage to garage. (A \$0.30 cent per mile charge will apply after the first 20 miles.)
- 5. Airport transfers will be calculated on the "Single Hour Rate Only" based on the vehicle size and subject to a \$10 charge for each 30 minutes of waiting time.

# OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1867. The certificate authorizes the transportation of passengers by limousine in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington, and Cass counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1867 on April 22, 2014. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the Application on an emergency basis. The Commission further finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective May 16, 2014.

#### ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective May 16, 2014, Accent Chauffeured Transportation, LLC, Omaha, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:
