## OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On September 30, 2015, VIP Service, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska filed an application for authority to establish limousine rates for its use as follows:

Fuel/vehicle surcharges apply for fuel over \$4.00 per gallon of ten (10%) percent, and increase at a rate of ten (10%) for each \$0.50 fuel increase above that.

Emergency action is requested.

The Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1905, which authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage in limousine service between points in Lincoln, Lancaster County, and between points in said county on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage would not be authorized. The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1905, on October 6, 2015.

The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

The application requests that the hourly charges be permitted as well as a fuel surcharge and a discount program for friends, family, employees or military personnel. The Commission finds that the proposed rate is competitive with the rates charged by companies providing a similar service and should be approved.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis. The Commission further finds that the proposed rates to be approved in this Order are reasonable.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective October 9, 2015.

## ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective December 22, 2006, VIP Service, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish limousine rates for its use as follows:
