OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 13, 2015, Limousine Services, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish additional rates for its use in its operations. The Applicant proposes the following rates:

Description	Proposed
Six Passenger Limousine	\$75/hr

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1761. The certificate allows the transportation of passengers by luxury limousine between points within a 250-mile radius of Dakota City over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: 1) The transportation of railroad train crews is not authorized; and 2) The certificate holder shall maintain a listing of its services in the Yellow Pages of the telephone directory serving Dakota City.

The new rate is for a 1989 six passenger limousine that the Applicant purchased and is placing into service. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rate is based upon anticipated expenses and current market trends for vehicles of this type. The rates are anticipated to be competitive with other companies providing a similar service.
