## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 30, 2017, Airport Transportation Company, d/b/a My Limo ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application for authority to establish its limousine rates as follows:

All Other Occasions: Two Hours Each additional hour	\$350.00 \$100.00
Any trips outside Lincoln in excess of 100 miles	\$50.00

Two hour minimum Deposit for Cleaning and expendables	\$50.00
Family, Friends, Employee, Military, or Special Promotions	10%-40% off

Fuel/Vehicle surcharges apply for fuel over \$4.00 per gallon of ten (10%) percent, and increase at a rate of ten (10%) for each \$0.50 fuel increase above that.

Emergency action is requested.

On October 31, 2017, Applicant was granted extended authority under Application No. B-1123 to transport passengers and baggage by limousine between points in Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy Counties, and between points in said counties on the

one hand, and on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes, with the following restrictions: the transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized; HHS designation is not authorized.

Applicant is seeking to establish its initial published rate in order to provide transportation services for its clients. The Commission finds that the proposed rate is reasonable.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as Applicant should be placed in a position to begin providing transportation services as soon as possible. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 7, 2017.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Airport Transportation Company, d/b/a My Limo, Omaha, Nebraska be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish its limousine rates for its services on an emergency basis effective November 7, 2017, as follows:
