OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 10, 1990, Shipper's Transportation, Inc., Grand Island, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority in Application No. M-13211 of George Harring, dba Harring Moving whose certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizes:

Household goods and office equipment by straight trucks between points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

In such application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant applicant temporary approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by applicant. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 11, 1990, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission pertaining to notice.

It appears that failure to grant such temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for 90 days from the effective date of this order pursuant to 75-319, R.R.S. 1943, as amended.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Shipper's Transportation, Inc. be, and it is hereby, granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of 75-101 to 75-804, R.R.S. 1943, as amended, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
