OPINION AND FINDINGS

Federal legislation (Public Law 103-305 -- August 23, 1994) having declared intrastate regulation of motor transportation a burden on interstate commerce, and, therefore, null and void as to all but carriers of household goods and passengers, the Commission should dismiss all pending applications which seek authority to transport property, except household goods.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application mentioned in caption be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
