OPINION AND FINDINGS

It was brought to the Commission's attention that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to correctly reflect the authority granted by the Commission in the application of Lincoln Storage & Transfer, Inc. The Commission has reviewed the files and records of the Commission and finds that a portion of the authority was inadvertently omitted from the order entered October 15, 1991.

From the evidence adduced in these proceedings and being fully informed in the premises the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

- 1. The order entered herein on October 15, 1991, should be corrected nunc pro tunc.
- 2. The authority should read as follows:
- A. SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:
 Household goods and emigrant moveables between all points
 and places in Nebraska, over irregular routes.
- B. SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:
 Office equipment and fixtures, business machines, and
 telephone and switch equipment between points in Nebraska
 over irregular routes.
- C. SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

 General commodities (except commodities in bulk) between
 points in Nebraska over irregular routes under continuing
 contract with Sears Roebuck & Co.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission, that its order entered herein October 15, 1991 be, and it is hereby, amended nunc pro tunc and that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be issued to Lincoln Storage & Transfer, Inc., setting forth the authority in the foregoing findings. All of the other findings, conditions and orders set forth in the previous order shall remain in full force and effect.
