OPINION AND FINDINGS


On April 24, 1995, the Commission entered an Order to Show Cause against Transport America, Inc., dba All-Star Movers, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, in Application M-13881, Supplement 1, as to why no action had been taken to proceed with its application.
