## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 13, 1999, Nebraskaland Leasing & Associates dba Nebraskaland Moving & Storage, Lincoln, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Harold E. or Elizabeth R. Howard dba Howard Transfer in Certificate M-12565 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Household goods over irregular routes from Lincoln and vicinity to and from various points in the state of Nebraska at large.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jhear.com/">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 14, 1999, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-319, (Reissue 1996).

## ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Nebraskaland Leasing & Associates dba Nebraskaland Moving & Storage, be, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order. Stat., Sections 75-101 to 75-801, (Reissue 1996), and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
