OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 12, 1997, TTEMM, Inc., dba Two Men and a Truck, Omaha, sought to extend the authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of household goods between points in and within a 50-mile radius of Omaha over irregular routes.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 13, 1997. Protests were filed by Blair Moving, on February 19, 1997, by Star Warehousing on February 21, 1997, by Ford Van Lines, Inc., and by Benson Transfer & Storage on February 24, 1997, and by A-1 Metro Movers on March 11, 1997.

On March 26, 1997, applicant moved to dismiss its application.

The Commission finds that the application should be dismissed.
