OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed April 30, 1998, Jim's Moving & Delivery Co., Inc., Omaha, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Robert D. Ambrosek dba Ambrosek Moving Company in Certificate M-14146.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 1, 1998, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

A timely protest to the granting of temporary authority was filed on May 7, 1998, by Star Warehousing Co., dba Apartment Movers of Lincoln; on May 12, 1998, by Borley Moving & Storage Inc., and on May 13, 1998, by Chieftain Van Lines, Inc.

By statute, an application may be granted if it appears that failure to grant the temporary approval may interfere with adequate and continuous service to the public. The Commission has no evidence that Robert D. Ambrosek dba Ambrosek Moving Company in Certificate M-14146 had operated since approval of its authority. Therefore, since there will be no interference with adequate and continuous service to the public, temporary approval should be denied.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for temporary approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Jim's Moving & Delivery Co., Inc., Omaha, be, and it is hereby, denied.
