## OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On March 24, 1998, Bailey Moving, Lincoln, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as M-14151. The application was set to be handled by modified procedure May 19, 1998, with affidavits to be on file with the Commission no later than May 12, 1998.

In spite of several communications with applicant, the applicant failed to file affidavits as required by the Commission.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before July 31, 1998, why its application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

## ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Bailey Moving, Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution on or before July 31, 1998.
