OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed April 20, 2004, applicant, City Delivery & Moving, Inc., Columbus, Nebraska, seeking approval to transfer stock ownership from Gregg Pagel to Craig Schneider and Shannon Schneider.

Notice of the application in caption was published in The Daily Record on April 21, 2004, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Since no protest was filed, Application M-14154 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. That applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform the service proposed and will be so qualified after the proposed change in stock ownership is affected.
2. That the change in stock ownership resulting from the proposed transfer of stock is consistent with the public interest and does not unduly restrict competition.
3. That a change in stock ownership pursuant to a transfer to Craig Schneider and Shannon Schneider should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application M-14154 for approval of a change in stock ownership arising out of the transfer of stock from Gregg Pagel to Craig Schneider and Shannon Schneider in Certificate M14154 be, and it is hereby, approved.
