OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed April 9, 2002, Mack Moving & Storage LLC dba Mack Moving and Storage, Holdrege, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Mack Moving and Storage in Certificate M-14129 and to merge with the authority granted to Kearney Moving Service in Certificate M-14127.

Applicant seeks approval through the transfer of authority granted to Mack Moving & Storage in Certificate M-14129 which reads as follows: Household goods between points in and within a five-mile radius of Holdrege over irregular routes. SUPP. 1: Transportation of household goods between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Applicant further seeks approval to merge authority granted to Kearney Moving Service in Certificate M-14127 which reads as follows: Household goods between points in and within a five-mile radius of Kearney over irregular routes. After the transfer and merger of certificates, the applicant would obtain the authority, infra, under one certificate Numbered M-14174, and M-14129 and M-14127 would thereafter be cancelled.

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Household goods between points in and within a five-mile radius of Holdrege over irregular routes. SUPP. 1: Transportation of household goods between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Household goods between points in and within a five-mile radius of Kearney over irregular routes.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 13, 2002, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 1996), section 75-319.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Mack Moving & Storage LLC dba Mack Moving and Storage will, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 1996), section 75-311, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal of extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
