March 21, 2007

Any stipulations and exhibits must be exchanged by the parties and filed with the Commission. witness lists exchanged by parties and filed with the Commission. requests for subpoenas shall be filed in writing with the Commission. No requests for subpoenas will be accepted after this date.

March 23, 2007

Any requests for a continuation or cancellation of a video conference hearing must be made to the Commission at least 48 hours prior to the start of the hearing. give timely party failing to notification will be responsible for payment of all charges incurred result of a improper notification. All fees incurred must be paid before future hearings will be scheduled.
