OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed December 27, 2006, Dudley's Moving & Storage Co., Inc., Ralston, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks a Permit to operate as a contract carrier of passengers by motor vehicle as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

Transportation of household goods by van between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes for the United States Government.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 29, 2006, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Because no protests were filed, Application M-14195 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service, and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 1996), and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
- 2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the following extent:

PERMIT AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of household goods by vans between all points in the state of Nebraska over irregular routes for the United States Government.

The application for authority should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application M-14195 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Permit shall be issued to Dudley Moving & Storage Co., Inc., Ralston, Nebraska, in Application M-14195, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Permit authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Reissue 1996), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct operations until a Permit is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
