OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed March 2, 2009, The Billings Group dba Quick City Delivery, Omaha, seeks to acquire, through transfer, the operating rights granted to Inter City Courier Systems, Inc., dba Quick city Delivery in Certificate M-13498.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 12, 2009, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Because no protests were filed, Application M-14207 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed extended service.
2. The proposed transfer of operating rights will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
3. The certificate issued in Application M-13498 is not dormant.
4. A certificate should be issued in Application M-14207 authorizing the following operations:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of household goods by straight trucks or small vehicles between Omaha and points within a 100-mile radius of Omaha over irregular routes

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application M-14207, be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Permit shall be issued to The Billings Group dba Quick City Delivery,

Omaha, Nebraska, in Application M-14207, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings; and that to avoid a lapse of authority, the Certificate issued in Application M-13498 shall be revoked and cancelled simultaneously with the issuance of a Certificate in Application M-14207.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Permit authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Reissue 2003), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
