OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 12, 2010, Umbrella House, Inc., dba Action Movers, Omaha, Nebraska, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Bryan E. Sloter dba Bryan's Team Moving in Certificate M-14140 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of household goods between points in and within a five mile radius of Omaha over irregular routes.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 18, 2010, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 2003), section 75-319.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Umbrella House, Inc., dba Action Moving, will, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.
