OPINION AND FINDINGS

An application was filed with the Commission on February 8, 2012, by Movers 4 Less, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as Applicant. Protests to the application were filed on March 13, 2012, by Chieftain Van Lines, and on March 14, 2012, by vonRentzell Van & Storage, Inc.

Several attempts were made to contact the Applicant as to what the status was of his application. As of September 9, 2014, there has been no attempt to prosecute the application.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before September 23, 2014, why its application should not be dismissed for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.


O R D E R


