## BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 14, 2016, an application was filed by King's Moving ("Applicant"), Gretna, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of household goods by straight trucks between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, on March 11, 2016. No protests were filed, and the Application was processed pursuant to modified procedure.

The Commission attempted to contact Applicant by mail and telephone regarding the pending application and the missing required affidavit of supporting shipper. On September 27, 2016, the Commission entered an Order of Pending Dismissal requiring Applicant to take action on its Application by October 14, 2016 or the Application would be dismissed. Applicant has not contacted the Commission nor complied with the requirement to submit the affidavit.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that Application M-14223, Supplement 1 for King's Moving, Gretna, should be dismissed for failure to take timely action.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. M-14233, Supplement 1 be, and is hereby, dismissed.
