SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1. In the matter of Complainant Wayne F. Rowe versus Defendant Bill Reid dba A&B Movers, the parties agree to enter into a compromise and settlement agreement as permitted by Title 291, Ch. 1, Rule 027.05 which satisfies departmental complaint 2944.

2. Participation in this agreement does not constitute an admission by the Defendant of any of the allegations contained in the complaint.

3. Defendant consents to the assessment of a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000) in satisfaction of the complaint with the amount of \$300.00 paid by certified check/money order on July 31, 1991 and the balance due and payable within thirty days thereof.

4. Included in this agreement and final order is a money order or cashier's check remitted to the Commission in the amount of \$300.00. These funds and the remaining funds due and payable within thirty <sup>days</sup> shall be deposited in the Commission's contingent liability account pending the issuance of the final order and shall then be transferred to the Treasurer within thirty (30) days of issuance of the final order.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Settlement Agreement  
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Upon the verified complaint of Wayne F. Rowe against Bill Reid dba A&B Movers, the Nebraska Public Service Commission finds:

Defendant is a motor carrier not authorized to do business in Nebraska as an intrastate common carrier. Upon complaint filed by the Director of the Commission's Transportation Department, the Complainant and Defendant reached an agreement to satisfy the complaint and presented to the Commission a settlement agreement and remittance in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for deposit in the Commission's contingent liability account pending final disposition.

The Commission finds the settlement agreement to be a just and proper remedy to this complaint. Defendant should therefore be released from liability for the violations alleged in the complaint.


O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that departmental complaint no. 2944 filed against Bill Reid dba A&B Movers is dismissed as satisfied by the settlement agreement between the parties. Defendant is hereby released from liability for the violations alleged in the complaint, Defendant not having admitted to any of the allegations contained therein.


