BY THE COMMISSION:

On the motion filed by complainant in this matter on November 24, 1993, the Commission finds and orders as follows:

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 13, 1993, upon the informal request of the defendant, the Commission allowed the defendant to make installment payments on the fine imposed by the Commission in its order in this docket entered on August 30, 1993.

In its order of October 13, 1993, revising the terms of its original order dated August 30, 1993, the Commission allowed the defendant to make monthly installment payments in the amount of \$200.00 per month commencing on November 15, 1993, and payable on the 15th of each month thereafter until the entire balance of \$2,500.00 was paid in full. The defendant then agreed to an added condition that upon the default of any monthly payment by the defendant or upon the discovery by the Commission that the defendant continued his illegal transportation activities, the entire balance would become immediately due and owing in full.

As of the date of complainant's motion for an order to show cause filed on November 24, 1993, the defendant had still not made his first monthly installment payment of \$200.00 and, therefore, is in default, and in contempt, of the Commission's order entered on October 13, 1993.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that defendant, Bill Reid, dba A & B Movers, be, and is hereby, ordered to show cause why he should not be held in contempt of the Commission's order of October 13, 1993, through his default in payment of his first monthly installment and thereby ordered to pay the \$2,500.00 fine in full immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant appear personally before this Commission at hearing in this matter in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, on December 13, 1993, at 10:30 a.m.
