BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 13, 1993, the defendant in this matter informally approached the Commission with a request that he be allowed to make installment payments on the fine imposed by the Commission in its order in this docket entered on August 30, 1993. The complainant's attorney, Mark A. Ludwig, was also present at the informal hearing.

By unanimous consent, the Commission determined that it would be reasonable for defendant to make monthly installment payments in the sum of \$200 per month commencing on November 15, 1993, and payable on the 15th of each month thereafter, with the understanding that the entire balance becomes due and owing upon default of any monthly payment by defendant or upon discovery by the Commission of any illegal transportation activities by defendant. The defendant agreed to the terms proposed by the Commission and complainant made no objection.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that defendant be allowed to make monthly installment payments on the civil penalty imposed by the Commission in its order of August 30, 1993, in this docket and that said payments should commence on November 15, 1993, and be payable on the 15th of each month thereafter in the amount of \$200 per month until the defendant's total obligation of \$2,500 is satisfied in full.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if defendant fails to honor the terms of this agreement or misses any one of the monthly payments, that his remaining debt shall become immediately due and owing in full.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's order of August 30, 1993, in this docket should be, and it is hereby, modified to reflect the allowance made by the Commission for the defendant to satisfy his civil penalty obligations in this cause under the terms described above.


