OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 12, 1993, Robert R. Logsdon, Director of the NPSC Transportation Department, hereinafter referred to as complainant, filed a motor carrier complaint docketed MCC-3072 against defendant, Grosse Transfer of Council Bluffs, Iowa.

On April 6, 1993, complainant filed a motion to dismiss the complaint upon discovery that defendant did not commit a second offense violation and after defendant agreed to make application for intrastate authority.
