OPINION AND FINDINGS

On May 20, 1993, Robert R. Logsdon, Director of the NPSC Transportation Department, hereinafter referred to as complainant, filed a motor carrier complaint docketed MCC-3081 against defendant, Northland Transportation, Inc. of Laurel, Nebraska.

On August 17, 1993, complainant filed a motion to dismiss the complaint for the reason that defendant had subleased the leased equipment in question to a sublessee carrier which does not dispute that the load in question complained of in complainant's petition was transported under the authority of the sublessee.

After due consideration of the motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that complainant's motion should be granted and Motor Carrier Complaint MCC-3081 should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that complainant's motion to dismiss be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Motor Carrier Complaint No. MCC-3081 be, and it is hereby, dismissed at complainant's request.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing set for August 31, 1993, be, and it is hereby, cancelled.
